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- A score of 0 means pupils in this school on average do about as well at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally A positive score means pupils in this school on average do better at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally A negative score means pupils in this school on average do worse at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally A negative score does not mean that pupils did not make any progress, rather it means they made less progress than other pupils nationally with similar starting points •
