Everyday Activities

Take turns to stir the mixture.

Push cars / wind up toys back and forth to each other - Take turns.

Take turns to add another block / beaker to the tower.

Washing clothes

Take turns to put clothes in / take them out of the washing machine.

Post Boxes and Shape Sorters

Make a post box from a cardboard box.

Take turns to post a picture or a shape.
